

The June 3rd 2018 WAYA meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm. Board members present were Melissa Pientok, Andrew Semb, Ed Slaby, Sami Becker, Matt Clatt, Trey Johnson, DJ Johnson, Laci Moats, and Pat Schorbahn. The minutes from the previous meetings were approved. Andrew presented the treasurer's report that was approved unanimously.

Feedback from the Pigeon Falls 10U baseball tournament was positive. The Pigeon Falls Lions Club would like to have another tournament next year. Next year would maybe be a girl's softball tournament.

Concerns from the baseball/softball season include other teams not following or knowing the new bat rules, umpires not knowing the rules, and league management not returning calls.

Other spring season topics include t-ball equipment is still missing, 14U and 10U black teams will not send players to the All-Star game, equipment collection needs to be better organized at end of the season, and there has been a complaint about an umpire being rude. There was a discussion about holding a coaching clinic for baseball/softball coaches at all age levels.

The WAYA membership year will change to run with the school year in 2019. That will make it easier to hand out school activity cards with the memberships.

Flag Football and Volleyball registration will be June 27th. This will allow coaches to get some practice time in before the season starts on August 21st and ends October 2nd. Rule changes will allow for the center to stay behind the line of scrimmage and block for the quarterback.

Volleyball has several coaches for the 3rd – 4th grade and 5th -6th grade teams.

The school activity cards that WAYA would give with memberships should be individual passes only, not family passes.

Other items discussed were players need to wear a mask whenever they are on the field warming up a pitcher. Any player post season parties should be held after the playoff season is over. The next meeting will be a coaches meeting July 10th @ 5:30pm with a WAYA meeting to follow at 6:30pm at the school. Laci made the motion to adjourn, second by Matt, and the meeting was adjourned at 8:40 pm.
