

The meeting was called to order at 6:31 pm. Board members present were Melissa Pientok, Sami Becker, DJ Johnson, Andrew Semb, Laci Moats, Matt Clatt, Ed Slaby, Crystal Sluga, and Pat Schorbahn. The September meeting minutes and the current treasurer's report were both approved.

Updates to the Larson Park don't look like they will happen. Plumbing is going to cost too much to make it feasible. Melissa will tell the Whitehall City Council that WAYA is not longer interested in heading up the concession stand project. Our other concession stand options in the park include cleaning and painting the current stand and see how long it lasts, using the concession area at the swimming pool, or purchasing a mobile concession trailer.

WAYA flag football season is finished. After parents were moved off the field, there were not any complaints about behavior. The idea of adding more teams for next year was discussed and it was suggested the football committee discuss that.

Volleyball is going smoothly. The 5th and 6th graders are playing games and a tournament. The 3rd and 4th graders are practicing and planning a skills night.

The gym has been reserved for the four Wednesday nights in January to hold the WAYA basketball clinics. Basketballs have been ordered and t-shirts will be ordered after registration.

The softball clinic with Viterbo that was scheduled for October 6th has been cancelled due to a lack of interest.

The newly formed tournament committee has not had anyone volunteer to be on the committee. Crystal made a motion stating that if no one steps up to be on the committee by the next meeting the committee should be dissolved. DJ seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Andrew made a motion to change the WAYA membership year to run with the school year. Sami made a second to the motion, which passed unanimously. This motion can now be brought up at the annual meeting for consideration. This motion would allow current members to participate in baseball/softball without buying a new membership.

The idea of hosting a family night at next summers Beef and Dairy Days was brought up. The need for new Board members was discussed. There will be 2 seats that will need to be filled at this years annual meeting.

Ed brought up the idea of installing a batting cage at Ekern Park in Pigeon Falls. The Lions Club is willing to help with project.
