This letter is to inform you of our upcoming Annual General Meeting, which will be held on February 10, 2019, at 5:00 pm in the High School Commons. **ALL** parents, coaches, umpires are invited to attend, as we will be electing new board members and voting on new constitution changes. You can see the proposed constitutional changes on the WAYA bulletin board near the elementary school office or online at www.wayawisconsin.com.

Voting on proposed constitution changes and elections for new board members will be held at the annual meeting. We have two spots open due to terms coming to an end in 2019. Matt Clatt and Melissa Pientok's terms are coming to an end. Brittany Halama and Stephanie Sartor have expressed interest to be on the ballot and serve as a board member and Melissa Pientok will run for re-election.

Baseball and Softball registration will also take place on February 10, 2019, following the annual meeting. Registration for T-Ball will take place at a later date as the T-Ball season will not start until mid-May.

Registration fees will continue to be \$35 per participant with a family cap of \$140. Our membership year will now run from July 1st to June 30th, rather than the original membership year of February 1st to January 31st. If this proposed change is voted into effect at the annual meeting, that means there will be no added membership fee for current members for the upcoming baseball/softball season. Another option for parents is to set up a uniform swap event online where parents can contact each other about trading or selling their old uniforms. We do have a few extras in select sizes from last year that we can sell on a first come basis at the General Meeting. Registration for 8U- 14U Baseball and Softball will close on February 22, 2019. Late Registration will result in a \$25 late fee and may not be accepted.

We are still in need of coaches and will be finalizing who will be coaching which age level in the coming weeks after registration closes. We will most likely have two teams at each level of baseball and one team at each level for softball.
